14. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

(a) *Postgraduate Diploma Programmes*

An Applicant for admission to Postgraduate Diploma of the University shall be

- (i) A graduate of the Obafemi Awolowo University with at least 3rd Class Degree.
- (ii) A graduate of any other approved University with a minimum of 2nd Class (Lower Division)

(b) *Masters' Degree Programmes*

An Applicant shall normally possess not lower than Second Class (Lower Division) Honours Degree of the Obafemi Awolowo University or any other approved University.

(c) *Master of Philosophy Degree Programme*

An Applicant shall possess a Bachelor's degree with First Class or Second Class (Upper Division) with CGPA of 4.0 and above

(d) *Doctor of Philosophy Degree Programmes*

An applicant for admission to the Ph.D. Degree programme shall be:

A graduate of the Obafemi Awolowo University or any other approved University who possesses a Master Degree with research thesis and a weighted coursework average which shall normally not be less than 60% (B+).

(e) **VERY IMPORTANCE NOTICE**

In addition to the admission requirements as published, ALL Candidates should please note that in accordance with the University regulations, they must satisfy the O'Level requirements for Matriculation into first degree programmes of the Obafemi Awolowo University, i.e. Five Credit passes in relevant subjects at not more than two sittings including English Language and Mathematics (where required).

All Applicants are required to prepare for a screening examination exercise
